

# **ENTRY FORM** 9th Annual CORONADO **FOURTH OF JULY** HALF MARATHON

Monday, July 5, 1982, 7 a.m.

## RACE FEATURES:

The course begins at the Coronado High School Track, runs along the golf course and the ocean to the Naval Air Base. A 9 mile loop is made on the Naval Base and the race finishes at the corner of 6th and Coronado. Splits will be given every mile, ERG and spray stations will be located at frequent intervals. T-Shirts will be distributed to finishers only, at the high school football field after the race. The post-race recovery area and medical aid will be located at the finish line area on the Crown school grinder. A full set of results will be mailed by the end of July to all entrants. Registration and finish-line procedures will be coordinated by End of The Line Race Consultants. PROCEEDS FROM THE RACE GO TO THE CORONADO HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC FUND.

#### SPECIAL TEAM COMPETITION:

There will be a 3 to 5 person "OPEN TEAM COMPETITION." To qualify for one of the five awards, a team must have its first three members cross the line in LESS THAN 72 MINUTES. The awards will consist of





a team trophy for first through fifth place, as well as individual awards for the first three finishers of the first five teams. Scoring will be by overall finish position. A team can be any group of 3 to 5 runners. There is no entry fee for this competition. Teams that can qualify are invited to contact George or Judy at 437-4556 or 437-4667.

#### AWARDS:

Awards will be presented to the top three male runners, and the top three female runners on the day of the race. There will be no "standard" division awards given on race day. Instead, the time of each finisher will be computer analyzed, taking into consideraion time, age, sex, and the distribution of times for each age and sex in the race, to arrive at a percentile rating on performance. The runners who score in the top 5% of all finishers based on these ratings, will receive a high quality garment (to be determined), not a T-shirt, with the above logo and appropriate description of their accomplishment. This method of recognition is age specific in that a runner (say 49 years old) will not be competing against youngsters of 40. If he or she does better than a 28 year old sub-70 runner based on the computer derived standards for his or her age, then he or she is placed ahead of the 28 year old in the standings. This method gives every runner an equal chance to win an award, regardless of age, as only performance against peers is considered. Winners will be notified within 4 weeks of the race. Please be certain to include age and shirt size on the entry form

The team awards and awards to the first three male and female finishers will take place on the high school track at 9:30

#### OTHER ACTIVITIES:

All runners are invited to attend the Coronado 4th of July celebration (this year held on the 5th), beginning at 10:00 with the FOURTH OF JULY PARADE down Orange Avenue, and ending at 9.p.m. with a fireworks display over Glorietta Bay. In between, you can watch a U.D.T./SEAL Air/Water show, visit the many shops in Coronado, and attend an art show in the park. If you want a real tune-up for the race, there is a one-mile rough water swim on the 4th. For information on the swim, call (714) 435-4179. If 13.1 miles is too far for the whole family to run, there is a three mile fun run beginning at 7:30 a.m.. The entry fee includes a Shirt (provided entrys are in by 22 June), and catered recovery station.
